New College Collections in Music

A quick guide for musicians. Please note the information below; these remarks are supplementary to the College rules on page 6 and 7 of the Handbook.

Collections

1) 'Collections' are College examinations which are held at the start of **each and every** term. They may also be held on other occasions.

2) They are compulsory.

3) Termly Collections are sat on the Thursday, Friday, and Saturday of 0th week; a reminder that you are required to be back in residence by noon on Wednesday of 0th week in **each and every term**, see *Handbook* page 4.

4) Music Collections are on occasion sat as takeaway papers or open book exams. These will often occur later than 0^{th} week so as not to clash with other collections.

5) Some Collections may at times be replaced with Mock Papers in preparation for University Examinations.

6) Mock papers may also be held at other times.

Content and Aims

7) The material examined is limited to that covered in the previous term, unless otherwise advised.

8) The aim of Collections is to moderate your progress, and may be marked pass/fail, or numerically, or given an indication of class.

9) The results do not count towards your next Public Examination result.
