¹ According to gender markers recorded in the University's eVision records system. EVision allows gender to be recorded as male or female. Students can record their preferred gender as female, male, or other. Preferred gender will appear on all student-accessed records and in data returned to the Higher Education Statistics Agency, but it is not visible to University and College staff, and is not used for aggregated reporting purposes as individuals identifying as other could be identifiable if intersectional factors (such as College, Department, or Ethnicity) are introduced.
